# Visiting Professor, Visiting Associate Professor and Research Scholar Positions

### Center for Ecological Research, Kyoto University, Japan

The Center for Ecological Research (CER) at Kyoto University, Japan is a Joint Usage/Research Center aimed at promoting basic research in a wide range of aspects of ecology and biodiversity. The CER is currently seeking applications for short term Visiting Professor and Visiting Research Scholar positions (see details below) who have a strong background and experience in one of the following areas: (a) biodiversity generated by animal-plant interactions in terrestrial ecosystems, (b) structure, function and conservation of aquatic ecosystems, (c) biodiversity and ecosystem function using either molecular or stable isotopic techniques, (e) theoretical research in ecology, biodiversity and/or evolution, and (f) ecological and evolutionary research related to biodiversity conservation.

#### **Outline of Positions**

#### (1) Positions:

Visiting Professor, Visiting Associate Professor or Visiting Research Scholar

#### (2) Duties:

This position is expected to contribute to the research and educational activities of the CER in cooperation with the host CER faculty member.

#### (3) Duration of positions:

About three months (longer than 90 days) during the period between October 1, 2023 and March 31, 2024.

#### (4) Financial support:

- a. Expenses for international round trip to Japan and domestic travel to the CER. Applicant is required to obtain an economically reasonable ticket because of the upper limit of the financial support for airfare, depending on the region of applicant's residence (contact your host CER faculty member for detail).
- b. Monthly salary is determined by the salary structure based on the applicant's qualifications and experience. It ranged between \(\frac{\pma}{4}\)50,000 and \(\frac{\pma}{6}\)50,000 in the FY 2022.
- c. Costs for required social insurance (welfare pension insurance and health insurance, etc.) will be deducted from the above salary.

### (5) Application package:
